

SNOW GUIDE

DO:

- Regularly check texts/emails for updates from SCA staff regarding storms and snow removal
- Keep a snow brush to keep in your car



- Keep an extra pair of gloves in your car
- Keep a set of jumper cables in your car; cold weather regularly causes issues with car batteries
- Purchase a pair of snow boots



- Make sure building entrances are closed behind you; sometimes snow build up can restrict them from closing
- Plan for extra travel time to/from work during a winter weather event
- Check the weather; stay informed of winter weather event predictions
- Help your neighbors; some residents have difficulties cleaning off their cars in the winter and would be appreciative of an extra set of hands!

SNOW GUIDE

DONT:

- Abandon your car in a drive path if it is stuck in snow; utilize snow shovels in the building entrance to dig out
- Park in someone else's spot
- Take an SCA snow shovel to keep in your car; these are intended to be available for everyone



- Expect to get to work/home in the same amount of time it takes in favorable weather
- Leave your car parked on a snow emergency street during a storm; check for the red signs below on street poles identifying snow emergency streets
